How formulated the lead singer of Queen Machine, which looks just like Freddie Mercury from the band they copy, here Thursday night, when they went on stage a little after 21 o'clock on Døllefjelde-Musse market.

It was the first time they played the market and then they got even the honor of shooting bededagsferien started as the first band on the big stage in the Market tent. And what a start.

There were well filled the tent when Queen Machine set the stage by playing the song "I wan't it all", a song which the audience knew well.

Crowd would be just warmed up, so to speak, finding the right Døllefjelde mood. But the band, and especially frontman was good to get completely over the edge and involve the audience.

He managed to get the whole tent to sing "Uh-oooh-Uuh" and ååh-ååh-oooh ". However, it was a minority of the crowd that could match the protracted tone, he put in. He must have filled the lungs with air, it seemed like he could go on forever.

There were played many wonderful recognizable hits and especially during "Do not stop me now" and "I wan't two break free" the audience could not stand still, and both sang and danced with the beautiful light show that bound the whole experience together .

The concert's climax waited a little on himself. After an hour, the band went by the stage, but was promptly called back to give encores.

Smash hit "We will rock" was fired and the audience stomped and clapped, emboldened by the band.

But the highlight and the most beautiful moment was the last number Queen Machine played. Lead singer took the microphone and dedicated number for the musician Prince, who earlier in the day had died.

The number was "We are the champions". The band played it with great empathy and the whole tent singing with. All in all a great start to the year Døllefjelde-Musse Market.
